#### Tournament Description

All of the matches for the Cup are played under Match Play Rules. The result of each Match is determined by the number of holes won. Eligibility: In order to compete for the Cup, players must be a student, past student, parent, past parent or employee of either Carver or Valentine Elementary School in San Marino. Match Play is a match where one player from each school competes against each other. At the end of the match, the player who has more holes won (points) wins with one point for their school. Ties are called 'halves' and players are awarded 1/2 point each. Handicaps will be in effect for those SCGA handicaps. If a player does not have a registered handicap but would like to participate and meets the above eligibility requirements, there will be a 'Modified Callaway' entry. Pairings will be decided by a representative from each school. Everyone is encouraged to play. This is a Friend-Fund Raiser and you do not have to compete for the Cup to be a part of the golf day.
