Dress Code

Appropriate attire is required for all persons on the Golf Course, Clubhouse and Practice Range areas.

MEN: Shirts with collars and sleeves must be worn at all times. Slacks or golf shorts, no shorter than four inches above the bend of the knee, or 17 inches out seam must be worn. Tank tops, tee shirts, athletic shorts, cutoffs, sweat pants; bathing suits, jeans or other athletic shorts are NOT permitted. Mock turtleneck tops are acceptable.

WOMEN: Dresses, shirts, golf style tee shirts, slack; golf shorts (no shorter than four inches above the bend of the knee) must be worn. Mock turtleneck tops are permitted. Halter-tops, bathing suits, sweat pants, jeans, athletic shorts or short shorts are NOT permitted.
